# Reception Curriculum Newsletter Autumn Term 2

Welcome to a new term at Grange Primary School. We have lots of exciting learning ready for your children this term! Nursery and Reception will be following a unit of work on a theme that focuses on 'Traditional Tales'.

During this half term, we will focus on:

- The Enormous Turnip
- The Three Billy Goats Gruff

We will also be reading a variety of non-fiction texts to help us explore more about the characters in traditional tales.
