## School Debating Team

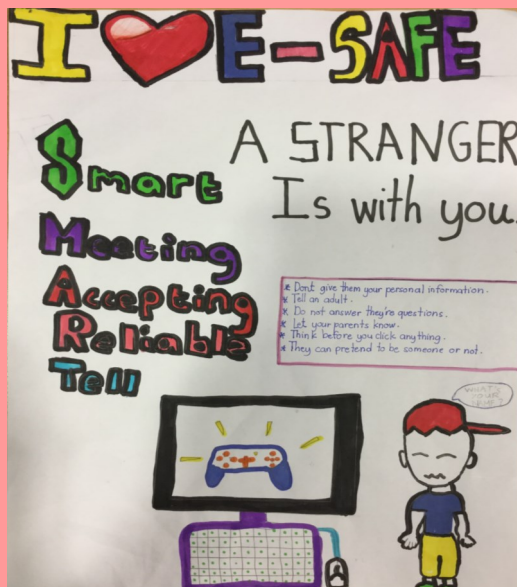
We would like to congratulate
