## MORAL DEVELOPMENT

At Grange we provide the following activities to support the moral development of the children:

- Behaviour Policy, Behaviour Plan, Anti Bullying Policy
- Consistency of approach: School rules, class rules, time out areas, traffic light system, reflection sheets, praise and sanctions
- Rewards for good behaviour: Team points/ end of term treats/ extra play
- Themed good work assemblies focusing on curriculum areas and IPC personal goals.
- Focused weeks: Citizenship week, Culture diversity week, Anti Bullying Week.
- Opportunities in the curriculum eg RE, PE, PHSE and IPC
- Workshops/projects in school: E-safety, anti-bullying
- Work with outside agencies eg Conflict and Change.
- The language of choice
- The work of the School Council.
- Peer support from play leaders peer mediators/ class monitors
- Opportunities for self evaluation/ peer evaluation
- Circle time activities

As a result of providing these opportunities the children at Grange develop a sense of:

- Ability to recognise the difference between right and wrong and their readiness to apply this understanding in their own lives.
- Understanding of the consequences of their actions.
- Interest in investigating, and offering reasoned views about, moral and ethical issues.
- Ability to listen and respond appropriately to the views of others
- Confidence to deal with set backs and mistakes.
- Initiative to act responsibly with consideration for others.
- Respect for the environment.
