- The start discussion was based around why we are setting up a PTA and what it is for.
- Links between home and school for the children.
- Events and fundraising.

- Parents then wrote down their suggestions for the school, what they would like
 to see happening:
 - Multi lingual letters for parents
 - Basic first aid for parents and children.
 - Emphasis on healthy eating (party days as well)
 - Cooking lessons with parents
 - Attendance why does sickness affect their attendance
 - English classes for parents
 - Community resources what can we do around Newham, what is available to us?
 - Craft activities
- Parents said they would like to see more workshops and activities available in school for parents and also for parents and their children to do together.
- Concerns were raised about attendance and worries about percentages going down due to illness. It was explained that this is part of the LA structure and will be put down as unauthorised absence, however as a school we are aware whether the reason children are absent is either due to illness or medical.
