<b>How the funding will be spent?</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Additional teacher to enable teachers to deliver additional catch up/intervention sessions</li><li>• National Tutoring Programme to target children identified as requiring additional support and small groups</li><li>• Purchase of new reading books for Reception and KS1</li><li>• Purchase of online resources (Bug Club/Mathletics/Rising Stars)</li></ul>	
<b>How will the impact of the fund on educational attainment be assessed?</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Baseline assessments (Salford Reading/Rising Stars/Maths No Problem/No Nonsense Spellings) to measure attainment in relation to age related expectations.</li><li>• Assessment shows, spellings across the school, KS1 reading including phonics and listening and attention in EYFS is affecting basic skills</li><li>• Quality first teaching for all children to address any identified gap and the robust training and development of staff to ensure the quality of teaching is good or better.</li><li>• Teachers deliver targeted interventions both summative and formative to groups and individuals</li><li>• Pupils will be assessed periodically to check that they are catching-up quickly and to measure progress.</li><li>• Assessment will be teacher judgment linked to summative assessment using a range of tests as identified above and EYFS baseline and standardised tests.</li></ul>
