## Year 1 Curriculum Newsletter Autumn Term 1

Welcome to a new term at Grange Primary School. We have lots of exciting learning ready for your child this term! Our Literacy text is **The Queen's Hat and The Queen's Handbag** Our class-reading book of the half term are books by Ethnic authors

This term we will be concentrating on – The Queen's Hat and The Queen's Handbag. English
