## Year 3 Curriculum Newsletter <br> Autumn 2

Welcome to a new half term at Grange Primary School. We have lots of exciting learning ready for your children this term! Holly class will be following a unit of work on a theme that focuses on The Bear and the Piano by David Litchfield.

Our core literacy text is The Bear and the Piano.

| English - The Bear and the Piano | Maths - Fractions, Measure and Number |
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| This half term, we will be looking at the story of The Bear and the Piano. <br> The children will be learning to: <br> - Explore the features of a fact file. <br> - Plan and write a fact file about the seasons. <br> - Explore the features of a postcard. <br> - Plan and write a postcard to inform. <br> - Explore the features of an informal letter. <br> - Plan and write an informal letter to friends. Grammar <br> - Capital letters, full stops and expanded noun phrases. <br> - Learn to recognise and use time adverbials. <br> - Similes and alliteration. <br> - Co-coordinating conjunctions (using 'or', 'and’, ‘but'). Reading <br> - To consolidate knowledge of phonics to read unfamiliar words. <br> - To read daily to improve fluency. <br> - To make predictions. <br> - To summarise the key points in a text. <br> - To use a dictionary and context to explore the meaning of words. <br> - To make inferences using evidence from the text to justify their point of view. | - Count up and down in tenths; recognise that tenths arise from dividing an object into 10 equal parts and in dividing one-digit numbers or quantities by 10 . <br> - Recognise, find and write fractions of a discrete set of objects: unit fractions and non-unit fractions with small denominators <br> - Recognise and use fractions as numbers: unit fractions and non-unit fractions with small denominators <br> - Interpret and write proper fractions to represent 1 or several parts of a whole that is divided into equal parts. <br> - Measure, compare, add and subtract: lengths ( $\mathrm{m} / \mathrm{cm} / \mathrm{mm}$ ); mass ( $\mathrm{kg} / \mathrm{g}$ ) <br> - Divide 100 into 2, 4, 5 and 10 equal parts, and read scales/number lines marked in multiples of 100 with $2,4,5$ and 10 equal parts. <br> - Tell and write the time from an analogue clock, including using Roman numerals from I to XII, and 12-hour and 24 -hour clocks <br> - Solve problems involving the four operations. |
| Science - Animals including humans | Computing - We are bug fixers |
| - To sort foods into food groups and find out about the nutrients provided by different foods | In computing we will be learning to: <br> - Spotting and correcting off-by-one bugs. |


| - To explore the nutritional value of different foods by gathering information from food labels <br> - To sort animal skeletons into groups, discussing patterns, similarities and differences <br> - To explain how the bones and muscles work together to create movement <br> - To design and carry out my own investigation. | - Spotting and correcting performance bugs <br> - Spotting and correcting multi-thread bugs <br> - Spotting and correcting conceptual bugs <br> - Spotting and correcting arithmetical bugs <br> - Spotting and correcting resource bugs |
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| RE - What is the significance of light? | PSHE - Healthy me |
| - To know why light is a special symbol <br> - To analyse the importance of Diwali to different people <br> - To understand how Christian people use the symbol of light <br> - To be able to apply the meaning of a story to modern day life <br> - To analyse what light as a symbol means to Jewish people <br> - To be able to explain the symbolic meaning of light | - To understand how exercise affects my body and how my heart and lungs are such important organs (2 weeks). <br> - To tell you my knowledge and attitude towards drugs. <br> - To identify things, people and places that I need to keep safe from, and can tell you some strategies for keeping myself safe including who to go to for help. <br> - To understand that, like medicines, some household substances can be harmful if not used correctly. <br> - To understand how complex my body is and how important it is to take care of it. |

| In Geography, we will be learning to: <br> - Locate the world's countries, using maps to focus on Europe (including the location of Russia) and North and South America, characteristics, countries, and major cities <br> - Understand geographical similarities and differences through the study of human and physical geography of a region of the United Kingdom <br> - Describe and understand key aspects of physical geography, including: climate zones, biomes and vegetation belts <br> - Use maps, atlases, globes and digital/computer mapping to locate countries | In DT we will be learning to: <br> - Research existing designs for seasonal stockings <br> - Plan and designing our own stockings <br> - Use a range of materials and tools to craft our stockings <br> - Implement decoration skills to be used when designing our stockings <br> - Prioritise safety when using various tools to construct the stockings. <br> - Personalise our stockings so they are unique and reflect the personality of the creator. |
